

These talents help him once he is recruited as cabin boy, musician, and eventually ship artist on a voyage led by Magellan. I found this book suitable for older children and young adults. Though the reading level is 5th-8th grade, the material is often at an older level. I would lean towards grades 7-9 as the youngest readers for this book.
