

The textbook gets so wordy that I find it hard to concentrate on the material. This book helps me tremendously. There is a pre-test before the chapter, the chapter then breaks the material down to what it is, symptoms, treatments, interventions, goals, nursing dx, etc. Then there is a post-test. I found several of the actual test questions to come from these pre and post tests and the tests on the CD. This book helped me attain my A's in med-surg. I highly recommend to anyone struggling with the drawn out standard textbooks.

Every semester my students ask which books on their list should be a priority, and despite this series NOT being a required text, I HIGHLY encourage my students to invest in Hogan's Reviews and Rationales series. The book is fine, but if you plan to use it for extra NCLEX review there are very few questions throughout the books chapters, and the website does not function as expected. Be sure you are buying this book as just a book and not for additional web resources you will not be able to access.
