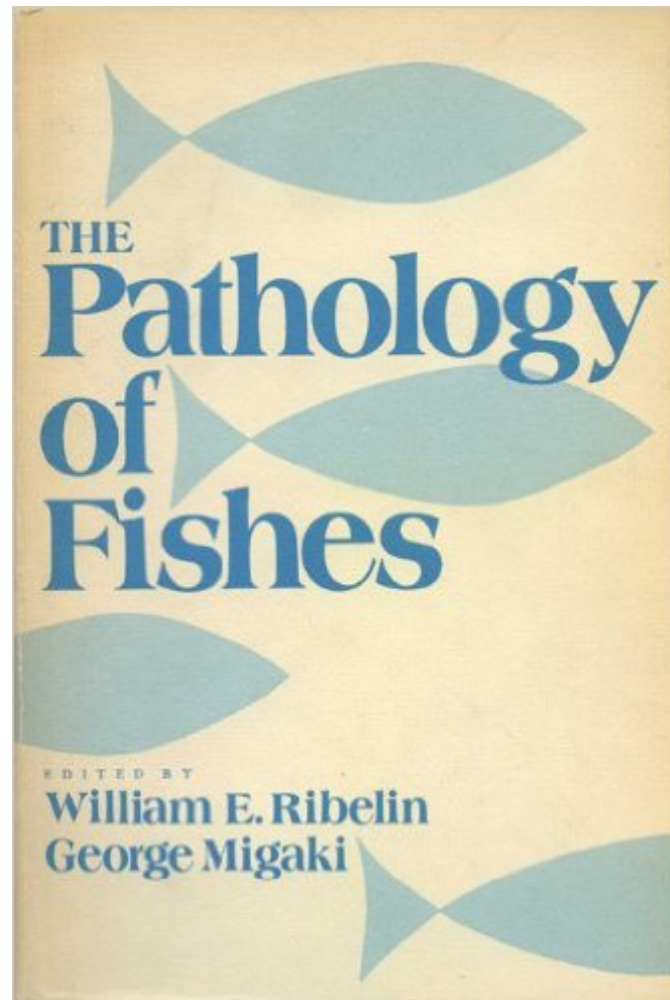

## Synopsis

Research workers, instructors, and students have long expressed the need for a comprehensive reference book dealing with fish pathology. More than 450 illustrations, including many photomicrographic enlargements, elucidate the text.
